- ☐ **Grade 4 6/8 March** (one tune of own choice (at least 4 parts))
- ☐ **Grade 4 2/4 March** (one tune of own choice (comp. type, at least 4 parts))
- ☐ **Grade 4 MSR** (Peine rules; one 2/4 March (2 parts), Strathspey (2 parts), Reel (2 parts))
- ☐ **Grade 3 MSR** (one 2/4 March (4 parts comp. type), Strathspey (2 parts), Reel (2 parts))
- ☐ **Grade 3 Slow Air/Jig** (one Slow Air or Slow March (2 parts, every part repeated), Jig (at least 4 parts))
- ☐ **Grade 2 MSR** (one set of own choice (at least 4 parts each tune))
- ☐ **Grade 2 Hornpipe/Jig** (one set of own choice (at least 4 parts each tune))
- ☐ **Grade 1 MSR** (three 4-part tunes each, the judge selects the set to play)
- ☐ **Grade 1 Hornpipe/Jig** (three 4-part tunes each, the judge selects the set to play)
- ☐ **Open 6/8 March** (three four-part 6/8 Marches will be proposed to the judge, the judge selects two to play as a set)
- ☐ **Urlar Open** (Peine rules; one ground of Piobaireachd of own choice, Grade 4 and Grade 3)
- ☐ **Piobaireachd** (Peine rules; one Piobaireachd of own choice, Grade 2 and Grade 1)
